Notice is given that under the Church Representation Rules a new Church Electoral Roll* is being prepared. Every person who wishes to have his or her name entered on the new Roll, whether it is entered on the present Roll or not, is requested to apply for enrolment not later than:

if the p (a) (b)	the Church Representation Rules, a lay person is entitled to have his or her name entered on the roll, person – is baptised, is aged 16 or over, and
(c)	has made one of the following three declarations and duly applied for enrolment.
	st declaration is that the person is a member of the Church of England or of a Church in communion witl is resident in the parish.
with it	econd declaration is that the person is a member of the Church of England or of a Church in communion, is not resident in the parish, but has habitually attended public worship in the parish during the ding six months.
with th	ird declaration is that the person is a member in good standing of a Church which is not in communion ne Church of England but subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity and is also a member of the h of England and has habitually attended public worship in the parish during the preceding six months.
to atte	eation Forms for enrolment can be obtained from the Church Electoral Roll Officer. In order to be entitled and the annual parochial church meeting and to take part in its proceedings, you must return the eation Form for enrolment by the earlier of the dates given above.
Any er	ror discovered in the roll should at once be reported to the Church Electoral Roll Officer.
